



Surfactants: Myths and Mythconceptions

Abstract

Are sulfates universally irritating or not? Are alkanolamides foam boosters or viscosity boosters? Both? Neither? How do surfactants solubilize fragrances? What's the difference between an emulsifier and a surfactant? We'll explore these and many other topics which vex users of all types of surfactants, from soaps to emulsions to conditioners. Bring your questions and leave your preconceptions at the door as we bust some enduring myths in formulating with these neglected and misunderstood workhorses.














SEPTEMBER - EDUCATIONAL DAY HIGHLIGHTS

What an amazing event this was - we had 7 wonderful speakers and a total of 175 attendees! Thank you to all who participated and thank you to our sponsors.



























































OCTOBER - TRUNK OR TREAT - BOO'S AND BREWS
















SCIENCE CORNER
