SCC CERTIFICATE IN SKIN CARE PROGRAM

Enrollment Opens For 2025-2026

This program utilizes a convenient online, on-demand delivery model (approximately 6 hours of recorded instruction per course) with quizzes at the end of each module to assist with knowledge retention. There will typically be a live online instructor Q&A session 3-4 weeks after the course's release date. 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
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IFSCC 2026 CALL FOR ABSTRACTS


